

Child Sexual Exploitation Briefing

- Indicators, signs, vulnerability factors and the impact of CSE
- Specificities of online grooming and guidance on how to talk to children about their experiences online
- Introduction to links between CSE and Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE)
- Good practice around disclosures
- Local and national referral procedures, as well as relevant agencies to contact
